# Locals escape the Dragons' Den with £300 for community projects

With the money raised at last year's Whiteway Fun Day, plus a grant from the Cobalt Trust, we asked locals to come forwards and pitch ideas for projects to run in their neighbourhoods.

On June 7<sup>th</sup> at The Centurion, community 'Dragons' George Samios (Head of Twerton Infants) and Emma Williams (Bleed Kit Fundraiser) then quizzed the brave candidates, before the audience voted for their favourite ideas. These were the ideas that secured £300 of funding each:

- Community walk up Pen-y-Fan (Dave Lakey)
- Twerton Flower Show community exhibition/party (Diana Ahmed)
- Tai Chi & Tech sessions (Andy Morley)
- **Play Equipment** for toddlers at Rose Cottage (Radical Mothers Group)
- Allotment accessibility improvements e.g. raised beds (TimeBankPlus)
- 'Twertopia' Drama Group (Stephen)
- 'Sugar Swap' healthy snacks for kids (Myowny Gordon)
- Books for young people struggling with cost of textbooks (David Lee)

We're planning to run another round in the Autumn so keep your eyes peeled and start thinking of what community project you could win support for!
